The waiving passenger:

The waiver may only be issued to the extent permitted by law. In the case of a general waiver, invalidity is assumed as a result of excessive liability within the meaning of Art. 27 of the Swiss Civil Code. Only a waiver in respect of slight negligence is permitted; the pilot remains liable for gross negligence, contingent intent and wilful misconduct. The pilot should keep the original waiver in a safe place and not carry it in the aircraft. The burden of proof for the issue and content of the waiver lies with the pilot. A waiver can only be issued between pilots in the same way as a pilot's licence if the waiving pilot does not perform a crew function during the entire flight.
